

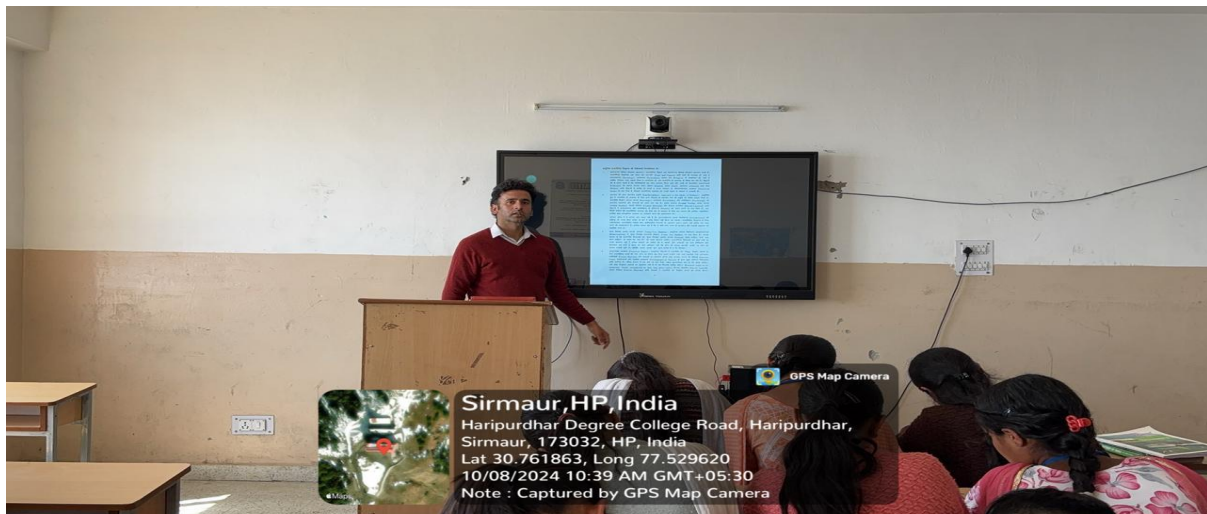

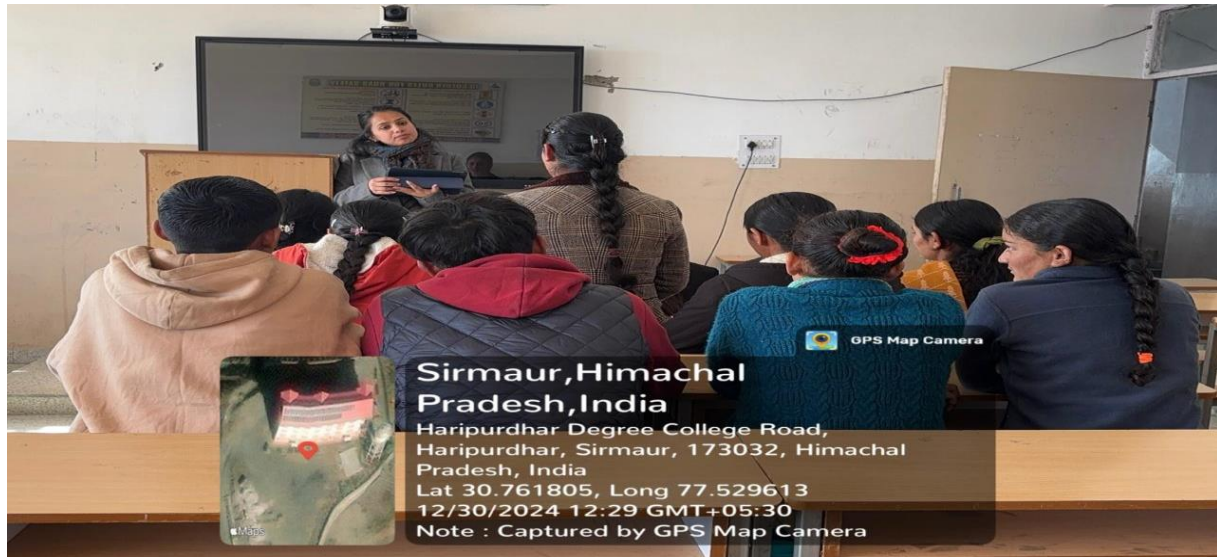

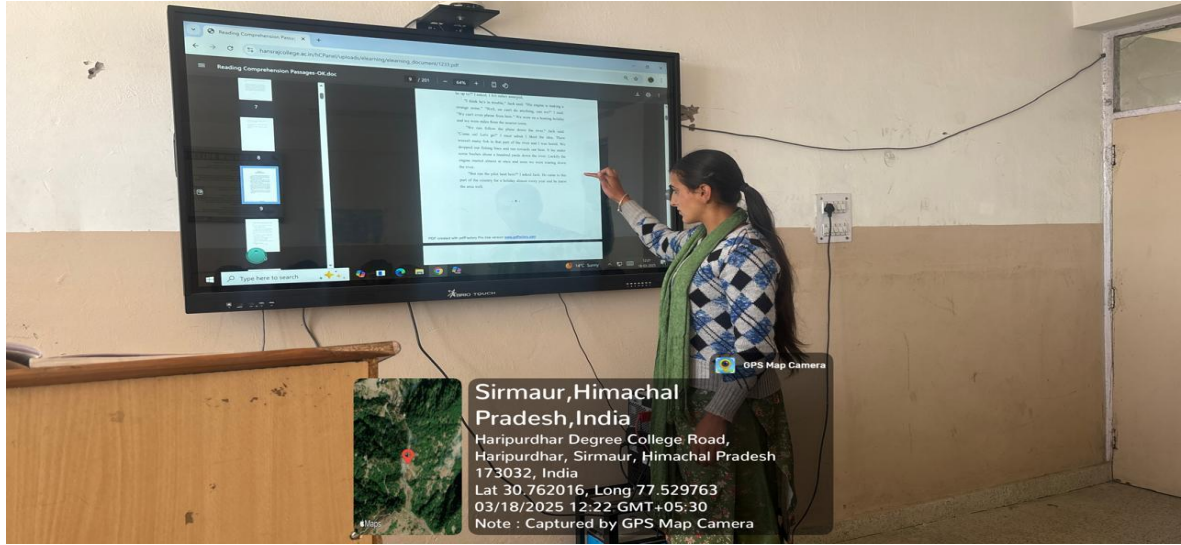






1.1.3. FLIPPED CLASSROOM

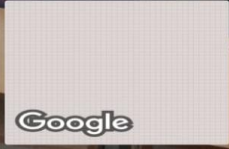


1.1.4. AS PER NEED OF DIFFERENT GROUPS OF STUDENTS

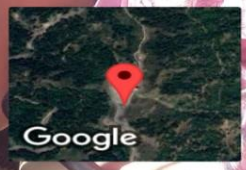

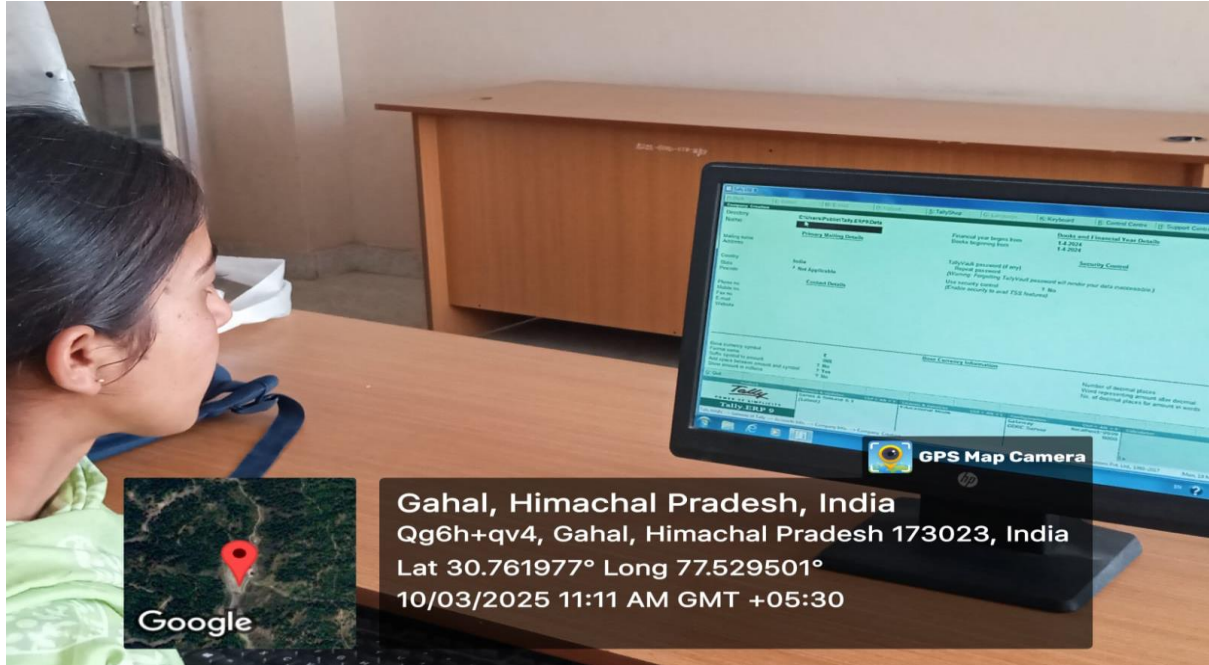
