

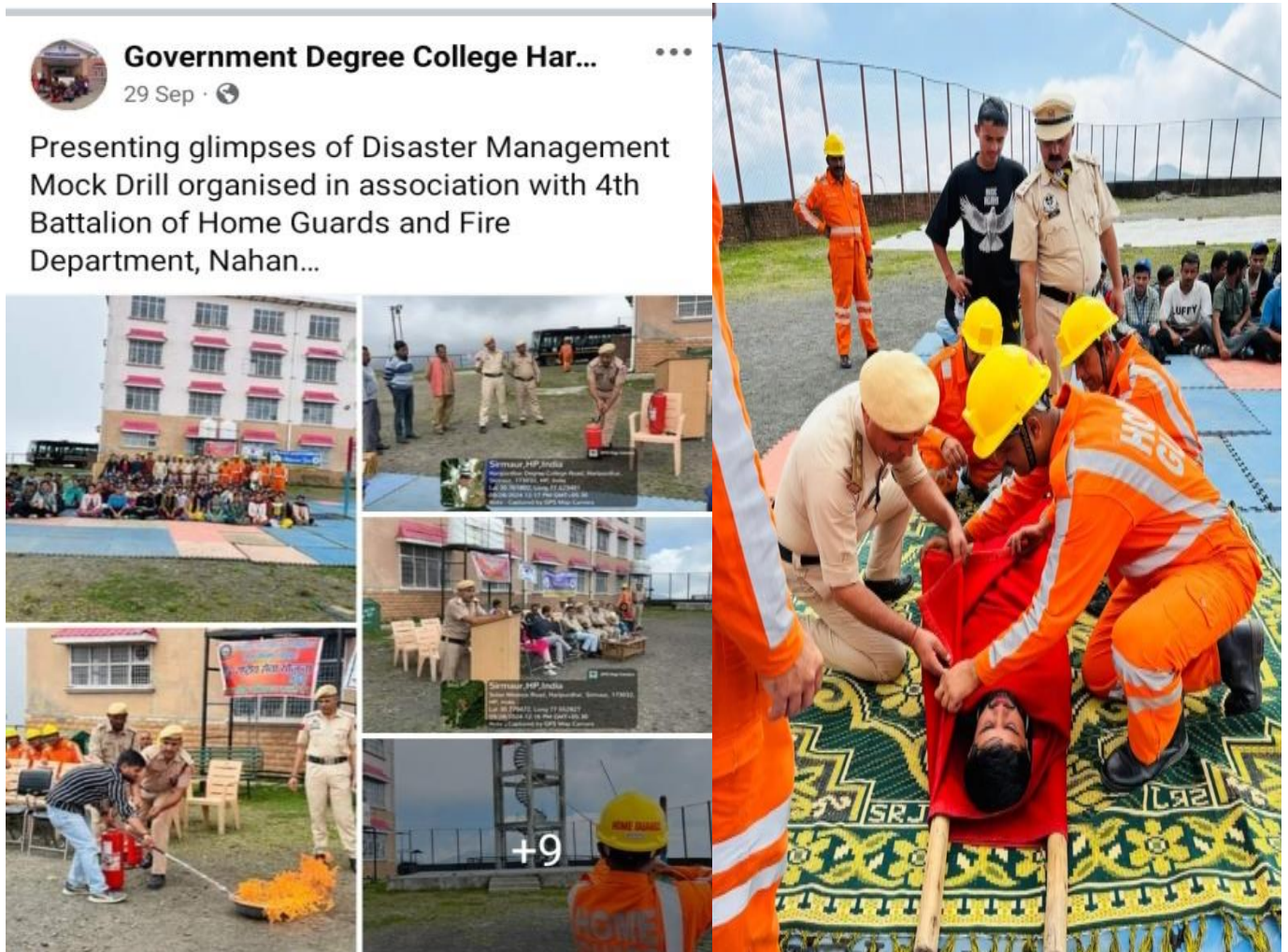




Introduction:

G.C. Haripurdhhar organised a one week dynamic Computer Skills Training Session for the college students from 7.10.2024 to 11.10.2024. The resource person for the session were Dr. Sarita Thakur, Assistant Professor Commerce from G.C., Haripurdhhar, Sirmour. The session was attended by the students of the institution. The daily curriculum included diverse topics to provide comprehensive learning experiences. The computer training program was for 1 hour duration.

The proceedings of the Lecture are as follows:

The Computer Training Program aims to provide students with a solid understanding of computer fundamentals and it enhance practical skills in using the internet for research and communication. Through such types of activities college provide a platform to learn the tools and techniques needed for the designing and development of digital resources for learning. The training was a mix of theoretical lectures and hands-on practice. In this session, the resource person introduced participants about the basics of MS Word, MS Excel, PowerPoint while helping them enhance their typing skills with the use of shortcut keys. Students also got some insights about the proper use of the internet. During this training session, students acquired essential skills such as document writing, editing, formatting, inserting tables and charts etc. The training also extensively covered Microsoft Excel which enables students to manipulate data effectively. Through power point, students learnt creating visually appealing slides, incorporate multimedia elements and deliver impactful presentations. 


