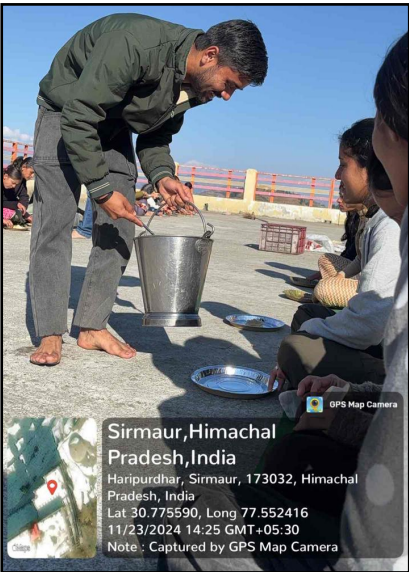

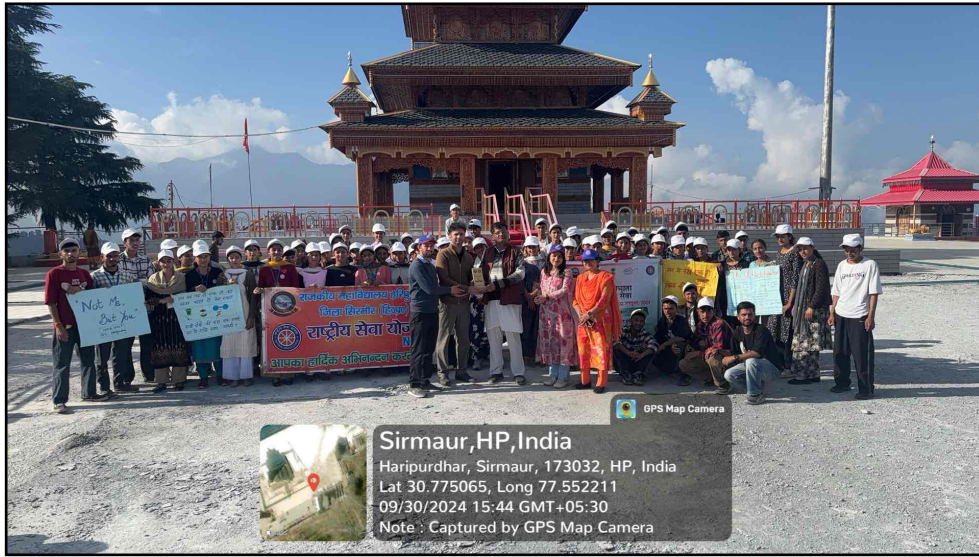

लाइव टाइम/नाहन : स्वच्छ भारत मिशन के तहत चलाए जा रहे स्वच्छता रैली सेवा अभियान के तहत राजकीय महाविद्यालय हरिपुरधर के एनएसएस छात्रों ने जागरूकता रैली निकालकर लोगों को स्वच्छता का संदेश दिया। छात्रों ने कॉलेज परिसर से मां भंगायणी मंदिर परिसर तक करीब 2 किलोमीटर लंबी रैली निकालकर जहाँ लोगों को जागरूक किया, वहाँ सड़क किनारे पड़े कूड़े-कचरे को भी साफ किया। एनएसएस प्रोग्राम ऑफिसर रोहित शर्मा और एनएसएस कॉर्डिनेटर हिमांशु ठाकुर ने बताया कि स्वच्छता रैली सेवा कार्यक्रम के तहत एनएसएस द्वारा स्वच्छता से जुड़े विभिन्न कार्य किए जा रहे हैं।

2. Maa Bhangayani Social Work Community: The college has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Maa Bhangayani Social Work Community, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 2006. This partnership supports the college in conducting socially relevant and community-based activities. As part of the collaboration, the community assisted the institution during the NSS seven-day special camp held in December 2024. On 17 December 2024, a cleanliness and awareness drive was held in the Haripurdhar market area with active involvement from the community and student volunteers. In another initiative, on 13 May 2025, the college and the Maa Bhangayani Social Work Community jointly organised a “Buransh Utility and Training Workshop” in collaboration with the Jai Maa Bijai Self Help Group. The workshop was aimed at empowering students and local residents by introducing them to the uses and benefits of the Buransh flower (*Rhododendron arboreum*), a locally available plant. The programme focused on creating awareness, building skills and promoting sustainable local practices.
